

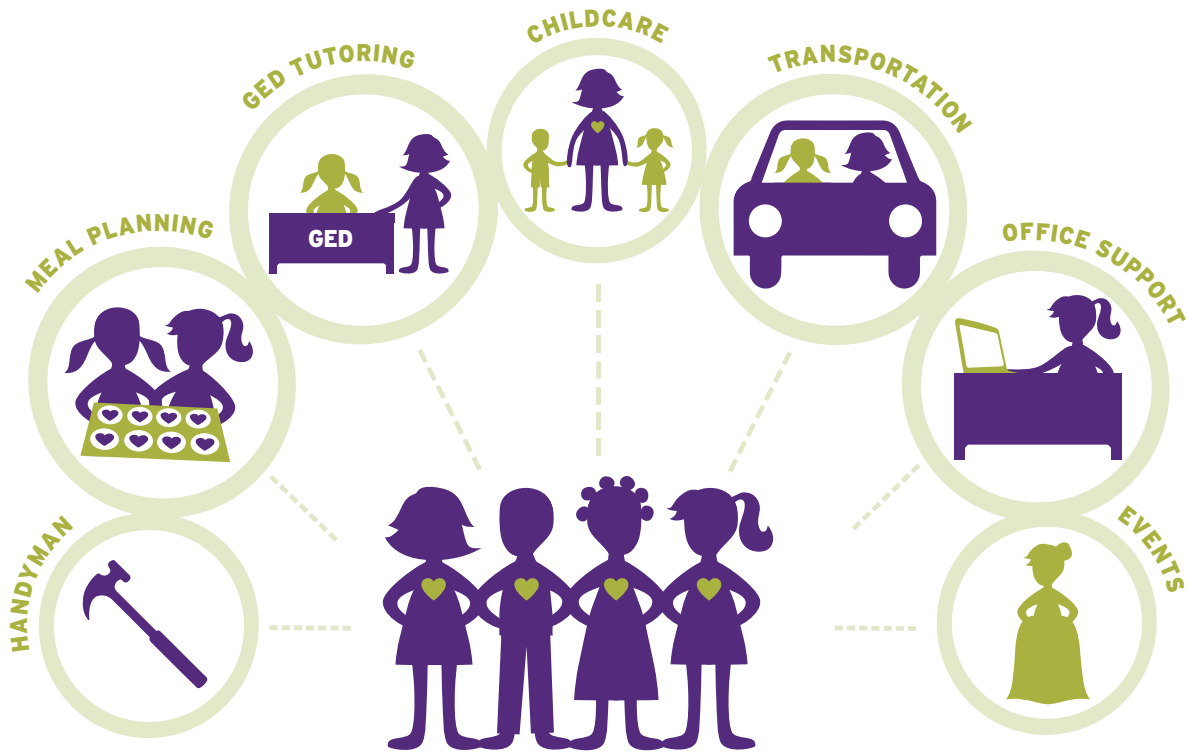

GIVE YOUR TIME:

- **HOPE RIDES (TRANSPORTATION)** - Take teen moms to and from appointments, school, shopping, in your own vehicle or Hope House van.
- **CHILDCARE-** Children of Hope House teen moms spend time in the Early Learning Room while the moms attend classes.
- **GED or COLLEGE & CAREER TUTOR-** in our Learning Lab- College degree not necessary.
- **HOSPITALITY COMMITTEE** - Prepare welcome baskets, gift bags for GED Graduates, etc.
- **MEAL PLANNER/GROCERY SHOP** - Help teen moms plan recipes for meals and go grocery shopping and cook with them.
- **OFFICE SUPPORT** - phones, filing, stuffing envelopes, etc.
- **EVENT SUPPORT** - Help with annual Hope House fundraisers and other special events.
- **FUNDRAISING/HOST A SMALL EVENT** - raise money for our self-sufficiency program by hosting an event to benefit Hope House.
- **BUILDING MAINTENANCE** - Help with house, building or landscape maintenance.
- **PRAYER TEAM** -Join our Prayer Team and receive prayer requests and updates regarding our teen moms and their children.
- **OFFER A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE** - Professionals can provide a free service for our teen moms and their kids such as medical, dental, vision, hair care and more!
- **JOIN A BOARD/COMMITTEE**
- **CAR MAINTENANCE-** Help a teen mom with minor repairs, oil changes, etc.
- **PROVIDE A MEAL** - Bring a meal for our teen mom classes. Homemade or take-out, our teen moms love it all!
